Nativity Fast (Advent) Begins Next Wednesday

On November 15 we enter the blessed season of preparation for Christmas known in the Orthodox Church as St. Philip's Fast, Nativity Fast, or Advent. This 40-day season is not nearly as penitential or strict as Great Lent, but nonetheless, it is a reminder to prepare our hearts for the Coming of the Lord. Every adult and teen should prepare at least one sincere Confession during this Fast. Fr. Justin is available most Saturday evenings and certain Sunday mornings, but also throughout the week by appointment.

Vespers for St. Matthew the Evangelist 6:30pm, Wednesday, November 15 followed by our weekly Christian Education Class. We will unpack the Ten Commandments and the Beatitudes, particularly as they relate to our preparing for Confession.

The International Orthodox Christian Charity (IOCC) will receive \$726 (proceeds from the benefit dance) to help those who are suffering. Reminder: The St. Elizabeth Sisterhood is sponsoring a spaghetti luncheon next Sunday for Fellowship Hour and all proceeds will also benefit the IOCC.
