### Parish Council Update

At the parish council meeting last Thursday, several new items were introduced and approved.

1. Revised Child Safety Policies & Procedures that include provisions related to registered sex offenders. Copies will be made available and posted on the bulletin board by next weekend.
2. New Facility Use Guidelines are in effect. The council approved a \$75 cleaning fee for any non-church related event; any waiver request would have to be presented to the council for consideration.
3. Narcotics Anonymous will begin weekly meetings beginning on Monday, February 11 from 6-8pm. Council met with 3 members from the group and were in unanimous agreement to allow these meetings as a community service.
