For many decades now, the Metropolitan of the Orthodox Church in America has urged us to set aside time on the Sunday following January 20 (the Anniversary of the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision to legalize abortion) to commemorate **Sanctity of Life Sunday**. In this commemoration we join millions of other Christians--Orthodox, Catholic, and Protestant--in reminding ourselves as believers that human life is sacred, beginning from the womb and extending to the tomb! We extend fervent prayers for the unborn, the afflicted, the infirm, and the aged, even as we seek to be more mindful of ways we can minister to and support human beings who fall into these and other vulnerable categories. Next Sunday, we observe this day and will add to the Liturgy a number of specific prayers relating to the sanctity of life.
