**New Fellowship Hour Format Begins This Sunday**

During this pandemic crisis, we must modify our fellowship hour plan to fit with the current guidelines for our parish. With the fellowship hall being used as worship space, this means we must get creative. The weekly fellowship hour team will be providing **only coffee** using the following guidelines:

- ◆ Coffee pots should be set up to brew on a table with wheels in the kitchen **before Hours begin** on Sunday morning.
- ◆ After Liturgy this table can then be rolled either just inside the side doors or outside on the sidewalk.
- ◆ The doors should be propped open to encourage traffic flow.
- ◆ Disposable products (cups/lids/stirrers) should be used for serving.
- ◆ Large trash cans will need to be available outside, both upstairs and downstairs.
- ◆ Clean up should include wiping down the coffee pots, the table and all creamer/sugar bottles.

Laura Walther and Mary Bradshaw have agreed to coordinate the Fellowship Hour this Sunday to get us started, and since next Sunday is the "5th Sunday" of the month, Rebecca Wilson and her team will be responsible. If you are a team leader or would like to be a team leader, please see Laura Walther and she will show you how to set up the coffee pots and answer any questions you may have. Knowing that some folks are not back at church yet, some folks have moved away, and others have new family commitments, the previous teams/leaders may change. Stay tuned for an upcoming schedule.

- \* **Friday Akathist/Confessions** begins at 11am on 8/28.

**Feast for the Beheading of St. John the Baptist** is next Saturday the 29th.  
*This is a strict fasting day (w/o).*

**Great Vespers** will be served on Friday at 6:30pm/Confessions 7:30pm.  
**Liturgy** will be served on Saturday at 9am.

**\$\$\$ Counter Ministry will begin again in September.** Are you interested in helping to count the weekly donations for tithes/alms/candles, prepare the bank deposit, and enter into the computer? In the past this has been done on Sundays after Liturgy, but it could be done at another time during the week, perhaps on Wednesday evenings. If you have helped in the past, or would like to learn how to do this process, please see Laura Walther as soon as possible so we can get a schedule prepared. Two people are needed each week and they cannot be of the same immediate family.

Our **Annual Parish Meeting** for 2020-2021 (*during which we are statutorily required to elect the parish council and confirm a parish budget*) will be held on Sunday, September 27. Due to Covid, our reports will be sent out in video and/or pdf format. Our treasury/budget discussion will take place via Zoom; but our voting will take place in-person, on both floors of the church, on Sept. 27 (abbreviated to about 10-15 minutes.)

For our **Parish Council 2020-2021, we have three open seats.** Alina Rizea is rotating off council; Chris Reeves (our warden) and Laura Walther (our treasurer) are willing to serve another term. So far, we have received one nomination, Jason McCord, to also serve on council for a 3-year term. If there are any other nominations to stand for the 3 open seats, please reach out to Fr. Justin before September 1.
