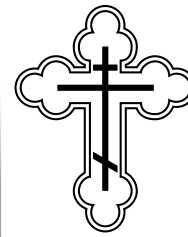

Today the Church remembers the Life of St. John Kochurov of Chicago

He was martyred on this day in 1917 by the Communists near St. Petersburg, Russia. St. John is warmly remembered in America because of his great labors in the American Midwest. Among his many legacies in our land is Holy Trinity Cathedral in Chicago, which remained the diocesan cathedral of the OCA Diocese of the Midwest. St. John built the church, which was completed in 1903 and dedicated by Patriarch St. Tikhon. May we continue to be inspired by the vision and missionary zeal and faithfulness of the Holy New-Hieromartyr John of Chicago.
