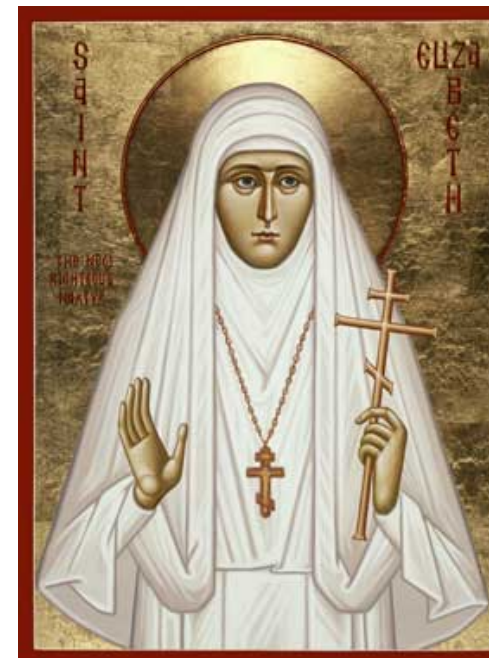

AAC Update.....From July 18-22,

St. Athanasius had 18 people attending the AAC of our Orthodox Church in America, held in Baltimore.

Fr. Justin and Zoe Kaylor served as our official clergy and lay delegate, respectively. Mat Tamara and the two Patterson sons attended as observers. Thirteen young adults attended due to the combined generosity of the remainder of our Telos Grant (from Lilly Foundation) and the OCA itself, which gave them free registration and banquet passes. For the course of the Council, Mat Tamara served on the OCA Committee on Canons and Statute (because of her expertise as an attorney and seminary graduate with interest in Canon Law.) Matushka was also elected to a 3-year term on the Diocesan Council of Archbishop Alexander. On Thursday, Fr. Justin was elected by the delegates of the AAC to serve a 3-year clergy delegate term on the Metropolitan Council, which is analogous to the Diocesan Council, but advises the metropolitan directly and works with him in executing the work of the OCA between AAC gatherings. Our auxiliary hierarch, Bishop Gerasim, is jointly spearheading a new office for youth with Bishop Andrei of Cleveland. Fr. Justin, Matushka, and others will be sharing on Wednesday night about the Council. Join us as we unpack these days together.
