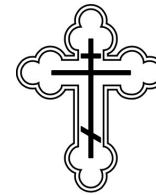

Following the final blessing, we will travel to High Bridge Park in Wilmore and gather under the pavilion for a picnic and an afternoon of fellowship. Everyone is welcome to join us as we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity.

The week following Pentecost is fast free ...enjoy!

Wednesday Vespers begins at 6:30pm, and following Fr. Justin will teach a one-time class on "A Tour of Summertime Feasts." All are welcome to come and bring desserts and drinks for this fast free Wednesday.

Liturgy will be served at 9am on Friday, June 9. Everyone is invited to the parish hall following for VCS brunch and outdoor activities until 1pm. Parents of VCS students are encouraged to come and enjoy this social time with their children.

Orthodox Christian Author Peter Erickson will give a talk on Wednesday, June 14 for our Christian Ed Class. The talk will be on his most recent novel, "Confessions of an Appalachian Colorhead" which is about one soul's struggle to be an Orthodox Christian in a fragmenting, post-Christian world. The talk will explore certain themes and the spiritual challenges he faced in producing this work of Orthodox Christian fiction. Copies of the novel are now available in the St. Athanasius Book Store for those who would like to read it prior to the talk. The cost is only \$10.
